1. Does the application read well? Does it hold your interest?
2. Are there typos or errors in spelling, punctuation, grammar or math?
3. Is the application neat and easy to read?
4. Is there enough detail in the budget?
5. Can you visualize what will happen in the project or instructional strategy?
6. Can you identify the need that is being addressed? Are the goals and objectives for the project or strategy clear?
7. Do you think that the project or strategy would support the learning goals identified?
8. Do the assessment measures seem sufficient for evaluating students' progress toward the stated learning goals?
9. In what ways might the school, parents, or community members benefit from this project or strategy?
10. What do you find creative or appealing about the project or strategy?
